

Seaside Route 218 Complete Streets & EV Charging Project

Monterey County - Route 218

Description

The Seaside State Route 218 Complete Streets and EV Charging Project is located on State Route 218 from Fremont Blvd to the Seaside State Beach Parking Lot. It plans to investigate the reallocation of pavement to accommodate all transportation modes, including but not limited to narrowing travel lanes, striping buffered bike lanes, adding green bicycle striping at intersections, sidewalks in both directions, pedestrian refuge medians, bus pullouts, and improvements at certain intersections. The project will also investigate suitable locations to install ZEV charging stations.

Purpose & Need

The purpose of this project is to transform State Route 218 into a genuine complete street, by implementing comprehensive, corridor-wide features including sidewalks, bike facilities, bus stop enhancements, crossing opportunities, and ZEV charging stations. The need is to make a meaningful mode shift away from automobile dependence, and by doing so reduce contributing factors to climate change.
